Other features of Vasont 8 include support for international languages as well as multi-language translation management, robust support for programmatic processing options, expanded workflow automation, batch and on-demand processing with asynchronous process support, integrated XSLT for XML transformations, detailed versioning support, content operation-level security, and an expanded API for programmatic access to Vasont functionality.
